esplandor De Vida (RDV), a Christ-centered home for impoverished children, located in the outskirts of Juarez, Mexico, opened in October 2010. Harvest Hands Ministries works together with Joaquin Estupiñan and his wife, Dalia, Directors of this home, and the RDV staff, sharing in a desire to help children and their parents overcome the challenges of severe poverty. Currently, twenty children call RDV home along with our full-time staff and their children. The directors and employees are dedicated to helping each child in all aspects of their development. This means concentrating on their physical, mental, and especially their spiritual well-being. Prayer, bible study, education, proper nutrition, rest and hygiene, music, tutorial help, and exercise are part of their daily lives at Resplandor De Vida. Having structure in their routine along with loving discipline has brought stability to what was previously for many a chaotic and dysfunctional life. Above all, teaching the children about the Gospel of Jesus Christ and demonstrating God's love will guide them on the path to eternal life.

About Our THREE Sponsorship Programs

HARVEST HANDS MINISTRIES offers THREE different SPONSORSHIP PROGRAMS:

- **1. CHILD SPONSORSHIP -** Your sponsorship assists in providing everything necessary to care for a child. The cost is \$45/mo. or \$540/yr.
- **2. STUDENT SPONSORSHIP** Student sponsorship includes sponsoring a child/adult for their educational needs at Resplandor De Vida Children's Home or in the area of Juarez & nearby communities. Currently, we are sponsoring 68 children/young adults. This opportunity will enable them to achieve their 6th grade, 9th grade, high school diplomas and for many, a college degree! Your sponsorship provides tuition, backpack, scholastic & sport uniforms, shoes, and more. The cost varies, generally from \$275-\$750 annually. The cost to sponsor an RDV child to attend school is \$540/yr.
- **1. INSTITUTO HARVEST HANDS STUDENT SPONSORSHIP -** Student sponsorship of a local community child enrolled at IHH, the Christian Primary School located at Resplandor De Vida Children's Home. Your sponsorship assists in supporting the operating expenses of the school including books, school supplies, breakfast, utilities, and staff salaries. Currently there are 123 local community children enrolled in IHH. The cost to sponsor a student is \$45/mo. or \$540/yr. Please see the enclosed coupon.

Message from the Mathewsons

t has been a busy year for Terry and I. Five mission teams came to Resplandor De Vida during the first seven months. It was good to have Terry escape the office and join me to host two of those teams. It opened my eyes to how important it was to have a woman's viewpoint and observational powers at the American team site to help organize and put things in order. Terry was blessed to be able to spend time with the children at RDV and IHH.

This fall I had the opportunity to share the ministry in WA State and then in New England at a supporting church with Terry. I then flew to MN to speak followed by driving a 'new to us' 15-passenger van down to El Paso with Jeff Caswell for the mission teams that will come to serve with us. A second van was also donated at that time for the children's home.

Harvest Hands Institute continues to grow, with 138 students enrolled this September. The school has been well received by the community and our reputation for offering a high-quality education has spurred this growth. As a Christian school, we can introduce Jesus Christ not only to our students but to their families as well. We embrace this privilege wholeheartedly.

How You Can Help: The children's home is a blessing to those who reside there, and Harvest Hands Institute touches the lives of more children each year. The growth along with other factors have brought familiar challenges to Harvest Hands in 2025 in a more critical way. The U.S. dollar has weakened in Mexico since January and with the increase in taxes and benefits for our nineteen employees, our monthly budget has seen an increase of approximately \$7,000 per month. We ask you to prayerfully consider helping us to care for and educate these children by supporting the work we have been called to for the past 26+ years in Mexico.

2025-26 HARVEST HANDS MINISTRIES PROGRAMS

RESPLANDOR DE VIDA: HARVEST HANDS has constructed a children's shelter on the outskirts of Juarez, MX. This is a home for impoverished children ages 4-18 and is in the Desert Farms colonia. God has called us here to work with the poorest of poor. Dormitories #1 & #2 are open and now have 20 children living there. The mission at RDV is directed by Joaquin Estupiñan and his wife Dalia.

HARVEST HANDS INSTITUTE: This primary grade Christian school officially opened at Resplandor De Vida in August 2023 and now has 138 students enrolled.

CHILD SPONSORSHIP: This is an opportunity for you to sponsor individual children at Resplandor De Vida Children's home. Please see page 4 of this newsletter for more information. Your help is a great assistance to keeping the doors open at RDV!

MEXICAN STUDENTS SPONSORED DURING THE 2025-26 ACADEMIC YEAR: This year 68 students are attending school from Kindergarten through University because of the scholarships provided by HHM supporters. Tuition, bus fare, books, scholastic & sport uniforms, shoes, sneakers, undergarments, backpacks, personal care items and school supplies are provided.

SCHOOL SUPPLY BAG PROGRAM: School supply bags were distributed in Mexico to needy children. These school supplies were purchased and assembled by friends of HHM.

CHRISTMAS SHOE BOX PROGRAM: Annually, Harvest Hands Ministries has a drive to collect gift boxes for children in Mexico. The list of suggested items to go in the boxes is found on our website. This year, gifts will go to the children at Resplandor De Vida Children's Home & Pastors Noe & Suky Beltran's church. The children are so delighted with these Christmas gifts!

SUPPORT: HHM supports Pastors Noe & Suky Beltran's church in Mexico and fully supports the directors and staff of Resplandor de Vida monthly.

SUNDAY SCHOOL MATERIAL: HHM provides Sunday School material to 3 churches in Mexico as well as Resplandor De Vida.

AMERICAN TEAMS HOSTED: Five mission teams were hosted this year. Teams are currently booking for 2026. A Short-Term Mission Trip Brochure is available on our website.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE: HHM helps the needy with prescriptions, medical needs and surgeries when possible.

FOOD DISPENSING: Visiting American teams make food bags to pass out in the local colonia (community) on their cultural day. Food is also dispensed at Pastors Noe & Suky Beltran's church.
