

How to pack a Christmas box:

- Use a regular shoe box with lid
- Choose which gender you would like to shop for:
 - o Bov
 - o Girl
- Choose which age group you would like to shop for:
 - o 2-4 years old
 - o 5-7 years old
 - o 8-10 years old
 - o 11-14 years old
- Fill the box with small gifts and items (suggestions listed on other side). Please purchase new items and be sure that all of them fit inside the box with the lid closed.
- Gift wrap the top of the shoe box separately from the bottom, securing the box with two strong rubber bands.
- Securely tape a 3×5 white index card to the top of the box and indicate the gender and age group, and place a duplicate card inside the box facing out on one end.
- Ship via USPS, UPS, OR FEDEX to the following address:

- sharp items such as nail files
- vitamins or food items
- aerosol cans
- used items
